Fat Bastard Burrito recognizes the importance of animal welfare, and we're proud to join leading Canadian companies in adopting the Better Chicken Commitment.

It is our goal to meet the following standards for 100% of our chicken by 2024:

- Maximum stocking density of 30 kg/sq. meter and prohibit broiler cages.
- Provide birds enriched environments including litter, lighting, and enrichment that meets Global Animal Partnership's standards.
- Process chickens in a manner that avoids pre-stun handling and instead utilizes a multi- step controlled-atmosphere processing system that induces an irreversible stun.
- Demonstrate compliance with all standards via third-party auditing.

And by 2026:

- Adopt breeds that demonstrate higher welfare outcomes, either: Hubbard Norfolk Black, JA757, JACY57, JA787, JA957, JA987, JACY87, REDBRO, or Redbro M; Aviagen Rambler Ranger, Ranger Classic, Ranger Gold, Ranger Premium, or Rowan Ranger; Cobb-Sasso 200 (CS200); Cooks Venture Pioneer, or others that meet the criteria of the RSPCA Broiler Breed Welfare Assessment Protocol or Global Animal Partnership (GAP).
